This Project consists of gut interior renovation of the cellar, first floor and second floor of the Chelsea District Health Center building to include a new STD Clinic, Immunization Clinic, General Health Clinic and support spaces. The project includes a new elevator, renovation of an existing elevator, a new stair and curtain wall, new accessible entry, new HVAC, cellar sprinkler system, new roof and rooftop mechanical screening, a new backup generator and select exterior renovation work. The project requires a minimum LEED Silver rating, and construction will be phased to allow the STD Clinic to maintain operations during renovation.
