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Project Description

This Project includes all structures and equipment, inshore platform repair, intersection safety improvements, and electrical work for the refurbishment of the marine transfer station. The following is a general description only, and shall not be construed as a complete description of the work to be performed. The principal items of work are: 1. Removal of building-associated equipment and appurtenances, including removal of existing truck scale and scale transaction booth and associated equipment including electrical wiring and conduit, 2. Inshore platform repair, 3. Dredging in areas shown in and around transfer station, 4. Construction of new underground utility piping and electrical conduit and encasement system, 5. Construction of to (2) new transfer station truck scales and associated equipment, 6. Construction of new intersection bike path and pedestrian walkway, 7. Furnishing, installing, testing, and placing, into operation the following complete ancillary systems: a. Communication – intercom system, b. Closed – circuit television system, and c. Ramp ventilation system.
