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REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Request for Proposals is amended as set forth below.

- (1) Section III F: Delete Section III F and replace with revised Section III F set forth below.
 - F. Payment Provisions: Payments for all required services for the Project shall be in accordance with Article 7 of the Contract. As indicated therein, the Engineer shall be paid for staffing expenses for engineering personnel identified in the approved Staffing Plan. Staffing expenses shall be calculated based on Direct Salary Rates per hour for specified titles of personnel, subject to a Multiplier for Overhead and Profit. Both the Direct Salary Rates per hour for specified titles of personnel and the Multiplier for Overhead and Profit shall be negotiated with the selected proposer. Negotiation is subject to the budgetary limitation set forth in Attachment 3.
- (2) Section IV D: Add new Section IV D set forth below.
 - D. Fee Proposal: A form for submission of the Fee Proposal is included as Attachment 3 to the RFP. Upon written notification, the proposer must submit the Fee Proposal in a separate clearly labeled, sealed package within ten business days of such notice. The Proposer must complete the Fee Proposal in accordance with the instructions on Attachment 3.





- (3) Attachment 3: Delete Attachment 3 and replace with revised Attachment 3 attached to this Addendum. There are four versions of the revised Attachment 3 attached to this Addendum, one for each borough.
- (4) Contract: Delete Exhibit B. Exhibit B will be finalized after negotiation with the selected proposer.
- (5) Contract: Revise the qualification requirements set forth in Exhibit C as follows:
 - Resident Engineer: Delete “Qualified for ASCE Grade V” and replace with “Qualified for A-III / N-III.” Delete requirement for “Valid NYS P.E. License”.
 - Office Engineer: Delete “Qualified for ASCE Grade III or NICET Grade IV” and replace with “Qualified for A-II / N-III.”

(1) Section III F: Delete Section III F and replace with revised Section III F set forth below.

F. Payment Provisions: Payments for all required services for the Project shall be in accordance with Article 7 of the Contract. As indicated therein, the Engineer shall be paid for staffing expenses for engineering personnel identified in the approved Staffing Plan. Staffing expenses shall be calculated based on Direct Salary Rates per hour for specified titles of personnel, subject to a Multiplier for Overhead and Profit. Both the Direct Salary Rates per hour for specified titles of personnel and the Multiplier for Overhead and Profit shall be negotiated with the selected proposer. Negotiation is subject to the budgetary limitation set forth in Attachment 3.

(2) Section IV D: Add new Section IV D set forth below.

D. Fee Proposal: A form for submission of the Fee Proposal is included as Attachment 3 to the RFP. Upon written notification, the proposer must submit the Fee Proposal in a separate clearly labeled, sealed package within ten business days of such notice. - Office Engineer: Delete "Qualified for ASCE Grade III or NICET Grade IV"" and replace with "Qualified for A-II / N-III."
