## General Construction – Medium Projects RFQ

Page 1 – last paragraph of *Section I. General Information*

Minority and/or Women-owned Business Enterprise (“M/WBE”) contractors selected for inclusion on this PQL will also be invited to apply to participate in the NYC Construction Mentorship and the Bond Readiness Programs offered through the NYC Department of Small Business Services. NYC Construction Mentorship is an 8-month program, starting annually each fall, which educates and mentors NYC M/WBE contractors to help them become more competitive in their pursuit of NYC contracts and hopefully win larger contracts with larger values. M/WBE firms participating in NYC Construction Mentorship will have the opportunity to take business and construction management classes led by industry experts, and to receive 1-on-1 mentorship and on-the-job training provided by an experienced construction management firm. Bond Readiness is a 7-month program, offered annually beginning each fall, that provides M/WBE construction and trade firms financial and business management guidance towards obtaining bonds or increasing bond capacity through workshops and 1-on-1 assistance.

**General Construction work for the Public Buildings division is to include, but not limited to the following:**

- New Additions:
  - Special Public Access Facilities;
  - Selective Demolition and Alteration Work;
  - Site Preparation
  - Earthwork
  - Concrete
- Commercial Interior Renovation:
  - Excavation, concrete, masonry;
  - Metals, wood, plastics, and composites;
  - Interior finishes, specialties, equipment, furnishings;
- Thermal and Moisture Protection;
- Conveying Equipment (elevators, escalators, lifts);
- Fire Suppression;
- Plumbing;
- Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning;
- Electrical;
- Electronic Safety and Security, communications;
- Earthwork;
- Exterior Improvements;
- Utilities;

**Note: Any contract for which the scope includes electrical or plumbing work, such work must be performed by an appropriately licensed subcontractor/s if the submitting bidder is not appropriately licensed to perform such work.**

**General Construction will not include:**

- Projects deemed by the Commissioner to be ones of historical significance or ones regulated by the Landmarks Preservation Commissioner or the New York State Historic Preservation Office;
- Projects utilizing Federal or State funding;
- Projects which are subject to continued environmental regulatory reviews, and/or inspections and/or in which contaminated and/or extensive hazardous material are known to be on site;
- Projects for which the primary scope requires mechanical, plumbing and electrical work;
- Projects for which the primary scope requires façade and/or roofing work;
- Projects for which the estimated cost of construction exceeds the range established for this PQL;

General construction services contracts for the General Construction – Medium Projects work for the Public Building division will be awarded by DDC through the use of a Competitive Sealed Bid solicited from the Pre-qualified List (PQL) generated from this Request for Qualifications.
